### Who are qualified to donate blood?

- You must be 18 to 65 years old. (16 and 17 may donate provided with parent's/guardian's consent).
- · You must be at least 110 lbs or 50 Kgs.
- · Your hemoglobin level must be at least 125 g/l (not anemic)
- · Your blood pressure must be between:

Systolic: 90-140 mmHg Diastolic: 70-90 mmHg

· Pulse Rate: 50 to 100 beats/min

Regular Rhythm

Generally in good health condition!!! The final medical assesment will depend on the physician/doctor on duty.

# HOW TO DONATE

- Have your weight taken.
- · Register and honestly answer the questions in the doctor's registration form.
- Your blood type and hemoglobin will be checked (if your are anemic or not).
- You will be examined by a physician.
- · You will now donate 450cc of blood for 5-10 minutes.
- · After blood extraction, rest 5-10 minutes.
- · Drink plenty of fluids.
- You may go back to your usual activities.

The normal human adult has approximately 5 to 6 liters of blood in the body. A healthy individual may donate 450cc of blood without any ill effects. This small loss will be rapidly compensated by the body. The fluid portion will be replaced within 24 hours and cell within weeks.

BEFORE DONATING BLOOD:

of blood as before the blood donation.

- Have enough rest and sleep
- No alcohol intake at least 12 hours

so that by the end of the month,

the body will have the same amount

- · No medication for at least 24 hours
- · Eat light meals, avoid fatty foods

AFTER DONATING BLOOD:

· Drink plenty of fluids like water and juice

- · Increase fluid intake like water/juice
- · Avoid stooping down
- Avoid strenous activities
- Apply pressure at the punctured site
- If there is swelling and discoloration at the puncture site, apply cold compress for 24 hours then hot compress for the next 24 hours
- · If there is dizziness, just lie down feet elevated. Drink plenty of fluids preferably something sweet.
- · If still you do not feel well, please inform the Bulacan Blood Service staff.



He/she will be temporarily deferred for 1 year.

How long does it take to donate blood?

The whole process of donating blood will take an average of 25 minutes only.

Will I contract any disease through blood donation? No, we use sterile, disposable needles syringes.

Will I put on weight or lose weight after blood donation? No, all you put on is the feeling of satisfaction of having helped someone.

#### How to avail blood from PRC?

The hospital where transfusion will take place prepares a blood request which should be given to the nearest PRC Blood Service Facility.

A corresponding Blood Processing Fee will be charged based on the type of blood component to be served.

Blood itself is free, having come from a volunteer donor. The fee covers the cost of collecting and processing.

#### Operating Hours of Bulacan Blood Service:



For Blood dispensing: 24 hours, everyday including holidays.

Gather friends and community members and we will come to your place.

A team composed of PRC staff will conduct the mass blood donation activity on yourchosen venue/place which should have good light and ventilation.

PRC will also provide the logistics needed for the activity, i.e. cotbeds, linens, equipment for blood extraction etc.

We can also send our Blood Service Representative to help you promote and discuss the activity.


