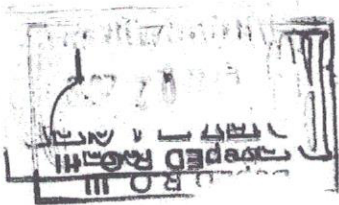

The National Economic and Development Authority Regional Office (NRO) 3 is in the process of accrediting PSOs in Central Luzon for the upcoming selection of private sector representatives in the Regional Development Council (RDC) III. In this regard, may we please request for the names and contact details of private sector organizations (PSOs) affiliated with your office.

RDC III is the primary institution in the region that sets the direction of the region's economic and social development and through which regional development efforts are coordinated. The members of RDC include local government officials, regional heads of departments and other government offices and private sector representatives (PSRs). PSRs comprise one-fourth of the membership of the RDC. The term of office of current RDC PSRs will expire in 30 June 2019, coinciding with the regular term of local elective officials.

The Implementing Rules and Regulations of Executive Order 325 titled "Reorganization of the Regional Development Councils" defines PSOs as organizations created or formed by private persons for the purpose of socio-economic development, providing service or assistance to the public. These include business organizations, non-government organizations (NGOs), people's organizations (POs), industry associations, religious organizations, cultural associations, professional associations, civic clubs and cooperatives. PSRs refer to qualified natural persons selected to represent the private sector in the RDC.

We will highly appreciate receiving the list of PSOs using the attached form on or before 12 April 2019.
