
Rest assured that the Committees together with their Troop Leaders will look for the security and safety of the girls.

QUALIFICATION OF THE PARTICIPANTS

1. Must be registered Junior/Senior/Cadet Girl Scout
2. Must be physically fit and alert
3. Must have earned at least one badge each under the 8-Point Challenge
4. Must have attended a troop/patrol/council/regional camp prior to this camp.

PARTICIPANTS

3 Patrols of Junior Girl Scouts or more + 1 Troop Leader per patrol

3 Patrols of Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts or more

Note: 8 girls per patrol

CAMP FEE

The camp fee is Three Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (P 3,200) per camper inclusive of program materials, food (*first meal November 15 dinner and last meal November 17 lunch*), camp souvenirs and other incidental expenses.

TENTS

A patrol tent (good for 8 girls) is highly suggested for better camp lay-out.
