GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Participants are expected to carry their medical certificate and parental consent, be accompanied by their respective Supreme Student Government Advisers (who shall be members of technical working group), and shall arrive at the venue on at exactly 7:00 am for setting up of the camping tents.
2. Participants are advised to bring the following: clothes for two days (including clothes for team building activities), food to share for lunch, dinner and breakfast (such as rice grains, canned goods, easy to cook food), handkerchief for blindfold, tent, beddings (pillow and blanket), pen, notebook, insect repellent, toiletries, tumbler,/ water jag, plate, spoon, and fork.
3. Camp training ID should be worn at all times for recognition and security reasons.
4. Wearing of shorts and sleeveless is highly discouraged when attending the sessions.
5. All phones/tablets should be put in silent mode so as to not disturb the flow of the program or workshop.
6. Everyone is encouraged to actively participate in the discussion and to listen attentively to the resource speakers. No one is allowed to stay inside the tents or go outside the camp site during sessions.
7. Parents are allowed to visit the participants after the sessions.
8. Culture of respect and tolerance is encouraged.
9. Certificates shall only be given on the last day of the activity during the Closing program.
10. Practice CLEAN AS YOU GO (CLAYGO) at all times.
