MECHANICS OF THE CONTEST

Term of contest:

Duration: 05 - 23 October 2020

Deadline of submission of entries: 16 October 2020, 11:59pm

Who may join the contest?

The photography contest is open to the member of the Regional Statistics Committee (RSC), all the Regional Line Agencies (RLA), and the Provincial Statistical Offices (PSO). Each participating agency/office is allowed to submit ONE (1) entry only.

Entry Requirements:

- Entry to be submitted should be in "JPEG/PNG" file format, A4 size (8.3x11.7 inches or 2480 x 3508 px);
- b. Entry should have corresponding **TITLE** and **CAPTION**. The caption must indicate the place where the image/photo was taken, a brief description of what it is all about and should not exceed 30 words;
- c. Entry should be in full color but no alteration/enhancement/filter is applied. Altered image/photo refers to photographs manipulated and applied effects. Such photo will be subject to disqualification;
- d. Entry must be taken from 05 16 October 2020 only;
- e. Entry should not infringe on the copyrights, trademarks, intellectual property rights of any person or entity, and that no other party has any right, title, claim, or interest in the entry;
- f. Entry should be submitted at psaregion3@gmail.com; and
- g. Entries will be published and posted in official Facebook account of PSA RSSO III on 19 23 October 2020.

Judging:

Entries will be judged based on the following criteria:


- a. Adherence to the theme (how well the photo interpret the theme) : 30%
- b. Creativity (how the entry showed some creativity ideas and uniqueness): 30%
- c. Technique (use of elements of photography like balance light, focus, etc.): 20%
- d. Number of likes (entries will be posted to PSA RSSO III FB Page) : 20%

Prizes:

The top 3 winners will be announced during the closing ceremony of the NSM on 29 October 2020. Each will receive a **plaque and certificate of recognition and tokens** which will be delivered to their respective offices.

Rules and Guidelines

Eligibility

- 1. The contest is open to all Provincial Statistical Offices, member of the Regional Statistics Committee (RSC) and Regional Census Coordinating Board (RCCB), and all the Regional Line Agencies (RLA) within Central Luzon.
- 2. Images of infographics that won in other competitions or have been used for commercial purposes or published will not be eligible.

Submission of Entries

- 1. Submitted images should be in JPEG/PNG format and should not have any watermark and not more than 10 MB in size and must be submitted by email at psaregion3@gmail.com.
- 2. Each participating PSO/agency within the region can submit only one (1) entry.
- 3. Entry should not infringe on the copyrights, trademarks, intellectual property rights of any person or entity, and that no other party has any right, title, claim, or interest in the entry.

- 4. The file name of the image should follow this format: provincial office name or agency name_date submitted (ex. PSAZambales_101620 or NEDA_101520).
- 5. Deadline of submission of entries is on October 16, 2020, 11:59PM.
- 6. Entries will be posted on the social media account of PSA Region 3 (from 17 23 October 2020) as part of the judging requirement.
