SUBJECT : **2020 IMPLEMENTATION OF MOBILE REGISTRATION SCHEME ON SCOUT MEMBERSHIP, CONDUCT OF THE PROGRAM AND ACTIVITIES, AND CONDUCT OF THE MEETINGS/CONFERENCES AND TRAININGS.**

1. In view of the on-going COVID-19 pandemic and its effects in the operations of the Bulacan Council, Boy Scouts of the Philippines, most especially in membership growth, the council management adapted the flexible and sustainable implementation of the 2020 Mobile Registration Scheme on Scout Membership, Conduct of the Program & Activities, & Conduct of the Meetings/Conferences and Trainings.
2. As membership and learning organization, we embraced the "New Normal" system by which the implementations of our council operations through programs, projects, activities, meetings and Membership Growth Campaign will be modified and adjusted through its guidelines and schedules of implementation, to wit;

2.1. MOBILE REGISTRATION SCHEME

We are pleased to announce the simultaneous implementation of the Mobile Registration Scheme on Scout Membership for the year 2020.

The Scheme calls for the registration on new scouts recruits and the re-registration of the expired membership in all scouting sections of all public and private schools in the province.

Objective of this scheme is to make it easier for the Scout Leaders to register their units during the scheduled period SET FORTH, starting NOVEMBER 2020, instead of travelling to the Council Office for the purpose.

The COUNCIL PERSONEL (Council Office Mobile Registration Team) will be set in two (2) groups to visit the different districts/schools to conduct the mobile registration membership recruitment. Attached herewith the schedule of visits to the districts/schools.

The Application Forms for Unit Registration (AUR) is ready for distribution to the different districts/elementary and secondary public and private schools in the province. It is suggested that the Application Form for Unit Registration (AUR) will be thoroughly accomplished before the scheduled date to avoid delays.

As our continued commitment to promote scouting as foremost organization in developing the young people to become agents of change in communities, education, peace and environment guardians, the following programs and activities will be offered by the Council Office:
