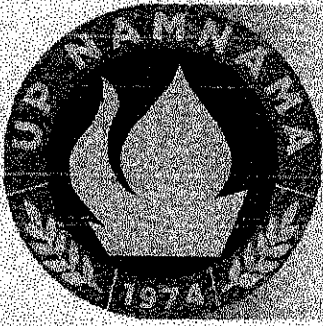
Event Profile

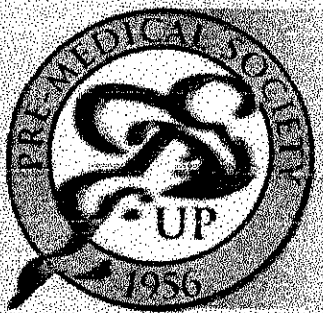
