Each event will have an afternoon session to run for about four-and-a-half hours (4.5 hours) per day, with a maximum of 1,000 participants consists of SK officials, LYDOs, LYDC Members, other youth leaders and invited guests from the respective regions.

This link will also be posted on the NYC, SK, and IAYSP social media pages. Participants will be accepted following the "**first to register, first accepted**" basis. Upon registration, participants will receive the forum link three (3) days before the scheduled event. **NO REGISTRATION FEE SHALL BE COLLECTED FROM THE INTERESTED PARTICIPANTS.** E-Certificates will be awarded to all participants who completed the whole program.

As the said activity is FREE of CHARGE, all Local Chief Executives are requested to encourage their respective LYDOs and LYDC Members to register using the above-stated link. All SK Officials are likewise encouraged to register and participate in the said event.
