Greetings from the Aboitiz Foundation and City Savings Bank, Inc.1

In 2015, Weather Philippines Foundation partnered with CitySavings to strengthen the Department of Education's disaster resilience by helping transform schools to become #WeatherWiser schools. To date, we have trained a total of 4,874 DepEd educators and DRR coordinators across the nation on Weather 101 and Tropical Cyclone 101.

This year, with the greater need to make schools more disaster-ready, we have updated the program so that educators and DRR coordinators will be more equipped in disaster risk reduction and management (DRRM).
