

#### **BACKGROUND**

In 1999, in its resolution 54/120, the General Assembly endorsed the recommendation made by the World Conference of Ministers Responsible for Youth (Lisbon, 8-12 August 1998) that 12 August be declared International Youth Day. The Assembly recommended that public information activities be organized to support the Day as a way to promote better awareness of the World Programme of Action for Youth, adopted by the General Assembly in 1995 through resolution 50/81 (Department of Economic and Social Affairs for Youth).

Series of activities are lined up leading to the month of October for the month of United Nations celebration. One of which is the International Youth Day (IYD) which is celebrated annually on 12 August "to bring youth issues to the attention
