3. The training shall be conducted to keep the participants equipped with skills on flexible system during the pandemic, so as not to compromise delivery of learning, with compliance to the standards prescribed in Policy, Organization and Rules of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines.
4. Training Modality:

Online Mode, Blended Mode/Self Directive Test, , & Round Table Sessions

- ONLINE MODE** This method will be used in the plenary, general sessions and ceremonies such the following:
- Opening & Closing Ceremonies
 - Course Organization & Routine
 - Defining Course Objectives
 - Ideals in Scouting
 - The Boy Scout Program
 - The Outdoor Program
 - Progressive Scheme and the Badge System
 - Annual Troop Program Planning
 - Course Summary

- ONLINE MODE** This method will be used in the sessions with Skills, Base System & Ceremonies Applications such the following:
- Flag Up & Flag Down
 - Smartness and Good Order
 - The Patrol System
 - Teaching Scout Skills
 - Songs and Games for Boy Scouts
 - Activities in Boy Scouting

- Ceremonies In Boy Scouting
- The Troop Campfire

BLENDED/SELF DIRECTIVE TEST

This method will be used in the sessions that can be a homework base. Each participants will have soft copy of sessions for them to read and study at home. The applications on this method will be a form of quiz such as the following:

- History of Scouting
- Fundamentals of Scouting
- WOSM & the BSP Structure
- Understanding the Boy We Serve
- Introduction to the Life Cycle of the Adults In Scouting (AIS)
- Values & Spiritual Development in Boy Scouting
- Keeping Scouts Safe From Harm

ROUND TABLE SESSIONS

This method will be used in the breakaway and base system sessions such as the following:

- Patrol and Troop Meeting
- Troop Organization and Administration
- The Troop Leader's Job

5. ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS to attend the Training Course:

- Must currently be registered to the Boy Scouts of the Philippines
- Must be physically fit as certified by a licensed physician
- Open to those interested to attend.

6. REGISTRATION FEE: Each participant will be charged **Eight Hundred Pesos Only (Php 800.00)** for the **Basic Training Course** to cover zoom applications, participants kit, training supplies, fuel for mobilization, reference materials, course souvenir materials, Training Staff/ITs meals other administrative expense may be charged to any Local Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations to defray the cost expenses if available.

7. PARTICIPATION: In order to ensure the conduct of the training course, there shall be a reservation fee of **One Thousand Pesos (Php500.00)** per participant. The first come-first serve basis will be applied to maximize the Course Application Recognition to the Regional Office.
