1. This training program is designed to help school leaders in creating a positive school culture and promoting whole-school organizational well-being by enhancing esprit d'corp, team connectedness, and intra-group communication as well as enhance their capacity to provide mutual support and empathy as a community in transition. It seeks to further renew teachers' commitment, strengthen their passion for teaching, ignite their enthusiasm for collaborative learning, clarify their sense of mission, and forge lifelong ties with students and fellow teachers within the context of ethical schools in these challenging times.
2. This training has been awarded a certificate of recognition in compliance with DepED Order No. 1 s. 2020 also known as Guidelines for NEAP Teachers and School Leaders with Program / Course Recognition No. R3-PD-2021-0033-1011. The said webinar is entitled to a PRC credit unit which teachers can use for the renewal of their license.
