## IMPLEMENTATION OF NATIONAL DRUG EDUCATION PROGRAM (NDEP)

- 1. The National Drug Education Program (NDEP) is one of the six major flagship programs of Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education (OK sa DepEd). Pursuant to National Drug Education Program (NDEP) (DM 200, s. 2016; DO 32, 37, & 40, s. 2017) An educational endeavor aimed to raise the consciousness of elementary and secondary students on the perils of use of illicit drugs, anchored on Republic Act 7624 of 1992 (An Act Integrating Drug Prevention and Control in the Intermediate and Secondary Curricula as well as the Non-Formal, Informal and Indigenous Learning Systems) and Republic Act 9165 (Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002).     - a) Orient participants on illegal drug abuse,
    - b) Educate students the possible cause and effect of using illegal drugs,
    - Develop knowledge, skills, and attitudes to appreciate the benefits of healthy living (which may
      or may not include the use of psychoactive substances)
    - d) Lead participants towards right and fruitful direction in life, and
    - Promote responsibility towards the use of drugs and relate these to their own action and those
      of others.
