- 1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 683 declaring the Month of February of every year as National Arts Month, this office shall conduct virtual orientation on Galaw Pilipinas: The DepEd National Calisthenics Exercise Program and the Division Video Competition of Galaw Pilipinas for teachers to celebrate National Arts Month with the theme, "Sining ng Pag-Asa" this February 24,2022 (Thursday) and February 28 (Monday), 2022.

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Guidelines and Criteria for the Division Video Competition of Galaw Pilipinas: The DepEd National Calisthenics Exercise Program

- 1. The competition is open to all DepEd Bulacan elementary and secondary publicschool teachers.
- 2. There are two categories in the competition:
 - a. Elementary
 - b. Secondary
- 3. The calisthenics exercise team may consist of all male, all female, or mixed members with a minimum of six (6) and a maximum of eight (8) teachers.
- 4. The team are advised to wear comfortable clothes when performing Galaw Pilipinas. They may wear their P.E. uniforms (if available) or jogging pants, t-shirt, and rubber shoes.
- 5. The audio-video recording must be done in a way that resembles the size and dimension of a live performance on stage. To avoid a blurry image, the video camera should be set on a tripod.
- 6. The performance should be recorded in the manner it is intended to be performed live, including the necessary attire, backdrop, and props. It is not advised to use pre-recorded sounds or music in the recording.
- 7. At the beginning of the video, introduce the name of the school and district.
- 8. The use of smoke devices and explosives for props are not allowed.
- 9. The first top 3 winners in the EDDIS Level Competition are qualified to join in the Division Level Competition.
- 10. The team should strictly follow the safety protocols given by the IATF in performing and recording the entry video for the competition.

- 11. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.
- 12. All participants should secure medical certificate from their physicians that they are physically fit to undergo such activities.
