INTRODUCTION and RATIONALE

The Council of Student Chapters (CSC) of the Institute of the Integrated Electrical Engineers of the Philippines, Inc. (IIEE) brings forth a series of webinar to gather high school students from different regions across the archipelago. This is an event entitled, *EEnvestigation 2022: Seeking for Footprints of Future*.

To warmly provide great opportunity for the college year, the EEnvestigation 2022 is established with a primary intent of opening the minds of the high school students of what Electrical Engineering and Electrical Technology were all about, and what future breaks it can provide. Moreover, to guide them on exploring and preparing for College to consider choosing these degree programs.

The said event is divided into five series set for different regions. The webinar will be held during the Saturday afternoon of the specified months above. Thus, there will be two speakers per week coming from each region. - April 16 (Grade 10-12 from Regions 5-6: Bicol and Western Visayas)
- April 23 (Grade 10-12 from Regions 7-8: Central and Eastern Visayas, and

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GOALS

1. Promote awareness amongst the high school students across the Philippines.
2. Impart technical and non-technical knowledge, skills, and attitudes to all the high school students.
3. Encourage the high school students to consider choosing the EE/ET as their degree programs in college.
4. Show school opportunities that caters EE/ET programs, where they can possibly enroll for college.

OBJECTIVES

1. To provide platforms for deeper understanding what were Electrical Engineering and Electrical Technology was all about.
2. To guide High school students to explore and plan for their future career when they choose EE/ET programs based on their individual interests, skills, and values they can consider as strengths for these degree programs.
3. To encourage K-12 students to actively participate in career orientation like this in order to enhance their academic and career experiences' linkage, and thus improve their degree program/career preparation and management.
