- 1. The office announces the conduct of ARCZONE Professional Development Programs for School Leaders in accordance with the DepEd Order No. 001 s.2020 articulating the Guidelines for NEAP Recognition of Professional Development Programs and Courses for Teachers and School Leaders, a free online course training to 893 Principals, Assistant Principals, and Head Teachers of SDO Bulacan.
- 2. The title of the program is "Instructional Leadership in The New Normal" that intends to train school heads to demonstrate the instructional leadership skills through flexible learning deliveries. The online lessons are composed of webinars, reading materials, exercises and feedback on their sample work using a Learning Management System.
