
*13 Days* = June 21, 22, 23, 24, 27, 28, 29, 30, July 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, 2022

*1 day* = July 7, 2022 (Thursday) Competition at CLARAA Main, San Fernando City

*1 day* = July 28, 2022 (Thursday) Competition (National Dancesport Championship) at CITILINK Hotel, 115 Dalahican Road Purok, Little Baguio, Lucena City

2. The objective of the activity is to compete for the regional level (Regional Dancesport Competition) and 2022 National Dancesport Championship: Palarong Pambansa Limited Face to Face Dancesport Competition.
3. Participants to this activity are 2 player-participants, their coach and trainer from San Miguel National High School.
