DEPED COMPUTERIZATION PROGRAM (DCP)

The Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) informs all concerned that the Information and Communications Technology Service-Technology Infrastructure Division (ICTS-TID) and Administrative Service-Asset Management Division (AS-AMD) are scheduled to resume the monitoring activities for DCP FY2018 (which was stopped due to the COVID-19 pandemic), and DCP 2019 to DCP 2020 including the laptop packages procured under Bayanihan Act 2.

The DCP monitoring teams composed of ICTS-TID and AS-AMD personnel shall monitor at least 10% of the total schools under the Schools Division Office:

- a. monitor the delivered packages;
- b. validate Delivery Receipts (DR) and Inspection and Acceptance Report (IAR);
- c. retrieve Property Transfer Reports (PTR) from DepEd Regional Office, Schools Division Office (SDO), and schools;
- d. validate actual utilization of DCP Packages;
- e. validate proposals for maintenance plan and preventive maintenance;
- f. validate mode of disposal of DCP packages;
- g. verify reporting procedures and warranty claim protocol.


- a. have never been a recipient of DCP packages;



The data gathered from the monitoring tool will form the baseline information that will be verified by DCP monitoring teams.


