



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5. All public and private schools shall have transitioned to 5 days in-person classes starting November 2, 2022. After the said date, no school shall be allowed to implement purely distance learning or blended learning except for those that are implementing Alternative Delivery Modules, (ADM) as provided for in DO No. 21, s. 2019 entitled "Policy Guidelines on the K to 12 Basic Education Program" and DO No. 01, s. 2022 entitled "Revised Policy Guidelines on Homeschooling Program".
6. Just to emphasize, Alternative Delivery Modules (ADM) are instructional on learning modalities that do not strictly follow the typical set-up for regular classroom instruction but follow the K to 12 Curriculum of formal education in content. It caters to learners who are in unique circumstances that hinder them from regularly attending classes inside the classroom.
7. The time allotment for in-person class hours shall be based on Annex1 (Elementary Education) and Annex2 (Secondary Education) of DO No. 21, s. 2019.
8. The transition to 5 days in-person classes entails adjustments to the school environment, learning modality, and additional protocols, as well as managing the mix of pleasant and difficult feelings. Hence the provision of psychosocial support during the first week (August 22-26, 2022) of the school year is necessary in promoting, protecting, and prioritizing the learner's socio-emotional well-being, and developing their coping skills for this transition.
9. The SDO's School Health and Nutrition and the DRRM Units are required to organize an online orientation and learning session for teachers on how to conduct the Psychosocial Support Activity Pack that DepEd Central Office developed with MAGIS Creatives.
