Rationale

APNIEVE-Philippines mission empowers individuals and institutions in promoting the values of Peace, Human Rights, Democracy, and Sustainable Development. It establishes networks and partnerships with local and international institutions interested in values education. Recognizing the crucial role of education. APNIEVE focuses on the preparation of teaching-learning materials and the training of administrators and teachers from all levels in the use of a holistic approach to education and the integration of values across the curriculum. It seeks to extend this collaboration with other institutions in activities like research and the teaching of international education and values education production and publication of sourcebooks and teaching-learning modules teacher training workshops using these materials, exchange programs for teachers and students.

The Basic Education Developmental Plan (2030) states that "Filipino learners are envisioned to be holistically developed in basic education, acquiring 21st century skills that will enable them to manage oneself, build connections, inquire, innovate, stay nimble, and serve beyond self. They must take pride in Filipino national identity and nationhood and aspire to flourish and have life skills, economic prosperity, socio-political stability, unity in diversity; be responsive, competitive; and live in a sustainable world by upholding the above-mentioned core values: Maka-Diyos, Makatao, Makakalikasan, at Makabansa.

Under Republic Act (RA) 11476 institutionalizing Good Manners and Right Conduct (GMRC) and Values Education, the new law mandates DepEd to carry out appropriate training for teachers and educators on GMRC and Values Education, as well as to provide them with adequate and relevant instructional materials to develop their capacity to teach the subject.

The Department of Education (DepEd) shall introduce GMRC through clear, distinct, specific, and concrete character-building activities such as role playing in the classroom, community immersion activities, teacher-parent collaborative learning activities, school-initiated values formation activities, simulated activities, and other forms of experiential learning.

Mechanics, Rules, and Regulations

- 1. The contest is open to all public junior and senior high school students in the region. There will be only one coach or trainer in the contest.
- 2. The contest duration is from July 15 to July 21 of 2022.
- 3. Submission of entry is limited to one (1) entry per participant only. Three (3) entries per division.
- 4. Entries should be in digitized format (at least 600 dpi with a file extension of .jpg)
- a) The raw file of the digital artwork should be drawn/illustrated in A4 size using Adobe Photoshop. Submit the file in the following formats: 1) Flat jpeg format, minimum 300 pixels 2) Original raw file. Filename is your name and artwork title. Example: juandelacruz_logo.jpeg, juandelacruz_logo.tiff.
- b) A brief description or rationale (not more than 500 words) explaining the components of the logo should also be included in the entry.
 - c) The logo should not carry the name of the artist.
- 5. The design of the logo should be in accordance with UNESCO APNIEVE Region 3 Verbum Agendo (words in action): A Compendium of Best Practices, Research, Instructional Materials and Teaching Strategies in Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao

- Originality 30%
- Creativity and Impact 30%
