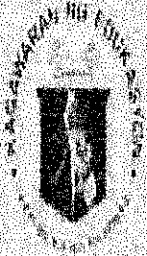

Rationale:

It establishes networks and partnerships with local and international institutions interested in values education. Recognizing the crucial role of education, APNIEVE focuses on the preparation of teaching- learning materials and the training of administrators and teachers from all levels in the use of a holistic approach to education and the integration of values across the curriculum.
