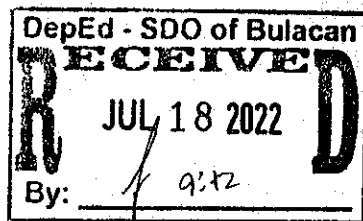


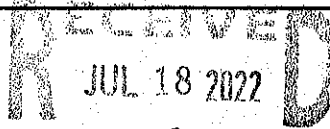


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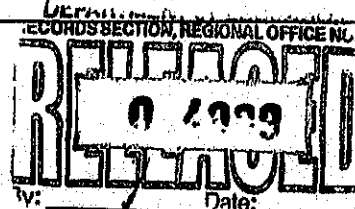

**REITERATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF DEPED ORDER NO. 34 S. 2022
ON THE CONDUCT OF FACE-TO-FACE CLASSES FOR SY 2022-2023**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Anent to DepEd Order No. 34 s. 2022 entitled School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2022-2023, particularly on item No. 15 of Enclosure No. 1, which states, **“Public schools that were already implementing the 5 days in-person classes at the end of SY 2021-2022 shall continue to do the same at the beginning of the incoming school year”**, DepEd Regional Office III directs the **3,595 Participating Public Schools** based on the Face-to-Face Classes Weekly Monitoring during SY 2021-2022 to adhere to the said provision (See Enclosure).

2. Meanwhile, the **91 Nominated Public Schools** that were not able to commence face-to-face classes last school year shall be given until October 31, 2022, to slowly transition by implementing any of the following options:

2.1 5 days of in-person classes

2.2 Blended learning modality

2.2.1 3 days of in-person classes and 2 days of distance learning (modular, online, or television/radio-based instruction); and thereafter, 4 days of in-person classes and 1 day of distance learning (modular, online, or television/radio-based instruction)

e.g. Mondays to Wednesdays (in-person classes) and Thursdays to Fridays (distance learning)

e.g. Mondays to Thursdays (in-person classes) and Friday (distance learning)

2.3 Full Distance Learning

3. The nominated public schools which will opt to employ Blended Learning Modality or Full Distance Learning are required to report to their respective Schools Division Offices for records and monitoring purposes.

4. All public schools are likewise reminded to maintain the readiness of the school operations and safety of the learning environment and conduct necessary





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preparations for the incoming school year. Schools Division Offices shall monitor the compliance of schools with the provisions of the said guidelines.
