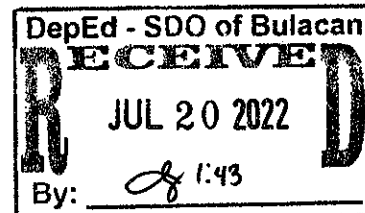

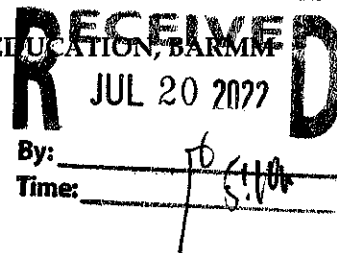

Interventions on the Blended Learning Modality*

The Department of Education (DepEd) through the Planning Service - Policy Research and Development Division (PS-PRDD) will conduct its annual research dissemination forum, the Research O'clock, which promotes the use of research results in decision making and provides DepEd personnel an avenue for information sharing and open discussion. Since its inception in 2018, 24 sessions have been conducted with a total of 79 topics presented, primarily from studies funded by the Basic Education Research Fund (BERF) and research results from external stakeholders such as UNICEF, Innovations for Poverty Action, and the University of the Philippines to name a few.

With the gradual transition to offering face-to-face classes in basic education, the theme of Research O'clock 2022 is "*Finding the Right Blend: Interventions on the Blended Learning Modality*", which will focus on the evidence and lessons learned during the implementation of distance learning modalities, and will showcase current interventions in the blended learning modality.

In line with this, we would like to invite you to attend the second episode of the forum with the topic "Exploring teaching and learning interventions in blended learning for elementary learners", highlighting evidence on teaching and learning strategies, the assessment of learning, and the learning gains under the distance learning modality.

The upcoming episode will be held this **July 26, 2022 from 9:00 AM to 12:00 NN** which will be live streamed via DepEd Facebook and YouTube pages. We will also accommodate in-person attendees at the Bulwagan ng Karunungan. Registration is strictly required for attendees joining in-person and we will only accommodate sixty (60) persons in the venue in observance of health and safety protocols against Covid-19.
