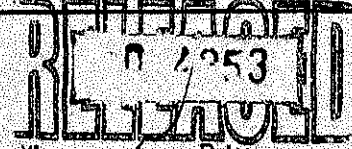

**SUBMISSION OF REPORTS RELATIVE TO THE OPENING OF CLASSES FOR
THE SCHOOL YEAR 2022-2023**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Curriculum Implementation Division Chiefs
All Others Concerned

1. In preparation for the opening of classes for School Year 2022-2023 for the transition phase prior to the implementation of the 5 days in-person classes, each Schools Division Office shall submit a report/data on the following for submission/presentation to the Department of Education (DepEd) Central Office:

- a. Number of schools, public and private, that will conduct any of the following:
 - a.1 5 days in-person classes;
 - a.2 Blended learning modality:
 - a.2.1 three days of in-person classes and two days of distance learning;
 - a.2.2 four days of in-person classes and one day of distance learning;
 - a.3 Full Distance Learning
- b. Number of learners enrolled per grade level as of July 28, 2022; and
- c. Issues, concerns, and challenges encountered in preparation for SY 2022-2023, and the interventions made.

2. The report/data for **items a to c** shall be submitted on or **before July 28, 2022**, by filling out the four google sheets with the link <https://bit.ly/3PVkplUc>. However, a soft copy of the report with the signature of the schools division superintendent must also be submitted by uploading it in the designated folder in the mentioned google drive link.

3. Moreover, relative to the return of the full face-to-face classes per DepEd Order No. 34, s. 2022, each schools division office shall prepare the following using the given templates in Enclosure No. 1 and submit/upload in the link cited above also on or before **July 28, 2022**:

- a. strategies and plans for the safe return of in-person classes;
- b. status of vaccination among teachers, non-teaching personnel, and learners; and
- c. plans to ramp up mass vaccination in partnership with the Department of Health and Local Government Units.
