2022 DIVISION BRIGADA ESKWELA KICK-OFF AND IMPLEMENTATION

1. In preparation for the opening of classes for the School Year 2022-2023 on August 22, 2022 and pursuant to DepEd Order No. 034, s. 2022, the Department of Education (DepEd) shall implement **2022 Brigada Eskwela Program** from August 01 - 26, 2022 with the theme, "**Brigada Eskwela: Tugon sa Hamon ng Ligtas na Balik-Aral.**" Thus, this Office will conduct the 2022 Division Brigada Eskwela Kick-Off Ceremonies on Monday, August 8, 2022, 9:00AM, at Virginia Ramirez-Cruz National High School, Pandi, Bulacan and will be streamed live via DepEd Tayo Bulacan facebook page <https://www.facebook.com/sdobulacan> and Bulakenyong MaPagMaHal <https://www.facebook.com/groups/434093223592984> facebook group. Districts and schools are encouraged to launch their own kick-off program.
2. The focus of this year's Brigada Eskwela is to engage all the responsive education stakeholders to contribute their time, efforts and resources in ensuring that all public schools are ready for the opening of the face-to-face (F2F) for the forthcoming school year.
3. The implementation of this year's Brigada Eskwela or the National Schools' Repair and Maintenance Period shall focus on the following:
 - a. Provision of immediate needs during disasters and calamities;
 - b. Addressing various resource gaps in relation to the reopening of the face-to-face classes;
 - c. Increasing learner's participation rate, reducing drop-outs and helping improve learning for both learners and community;
 - d. Creation of a network of community-based organization to get total community commitment for collaborative programs and projects as well as to strengthen Brigada Pagbasa initiatives;
4. The Brigada Pagbasa, as part of Brigada Eskwela, is an after-school reading program that envisions bringing together education partners and experts to help all learners read and become functionally literate. This program will serve as a platform to synergize efforts and resources to address education-related challenges



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especially on literacy and numeracy. It will also create opportunities for all stakeholders to contribute possible solutions to the current gaps in our education system, especially in equipping the learners with 21st century skills. All School Heads and *Brigada Eskwela* coordinators are encouraged to call up for *Brigada Pagbasa* volunteers.

6. Schools Division Office personnel, including unit heads from the Office of the Schools Division Superintendent (OSDS), Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), and School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) are enjoined to participate in various activities related to the *Brigada Eskwela*, including but not limited to monitoring of its implementation.
