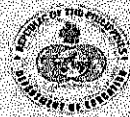

6. Mechanics of the Search.

a. The Regional Search for Best EGPP school implementer is open to all public elementary and secondary schools in DepEd Central Luzon, whether the school is recipient or non-recipient of GPP financial assistance from DepEd Central Office or partnered NGAs or NGOs.

b. The Search is composed of two categories.

1. Best EGPP-Project GAME School Implementer in Elementary
2. Best EGPP-Project GAME School Implementer in Secondary

c. Each SDO shall submit one (1) entry per category using the attached template on or before November 11, 2022 through this link: <https://tinyurl.com/2022EGPPentries>. Late submission of list of entries shall not be accepted.

d. Means of verification (MOVs) as indicated in the criteria must be presented during the onsite validation to the Regional Search Committee, otherwise no points shall be given. The criteria for Search are attached in this Memorandum.

e. During the onsite validation, school is requested to prepare and present the 2021 Gulayan sa Paraalan Program accomplishment report to the RSC.

f. School with highest garnered scores shall be declared as Best Enhanced Gulayan sa Paaralan (EGPP)-Project GAME Regional Winner in each category.

7. Winners shall receive the following prizes and non-winning nominees shall receive a certificate of recognition as finalist.
