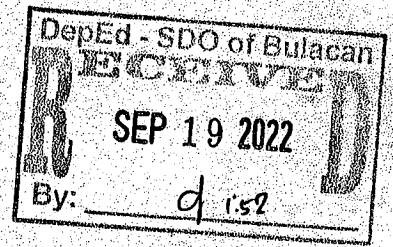


Further, we also request your good office to release a Regional Advisory for the conduct of the activity. Attached herewith is the Activity Design for your perusal.


