

PEP is a National Teachers' Training Program on Culture-Based Teaching in the different learning areas. It is a three (3) day Island-Cluster orientation, training, and consultation on the different facets of culture-based education, with a maximum of 100-pax participants per island cluster.

The project seeks to provide a unified culture-based approach to the teaching of Basic Education Curriculum. Strongly aligned with the program objectives of the NCCA Philippine Cultural Education Plan, the seminar-workshop intends to familiarize teachers regarding the nature, purview, methods, approaches and frameworks of culture-based learning and instruction.
