HYBRID DIVISION CONTEXTUALIZATION OF THE CURRICULUM FOR INDIGENOUS PEOPLES EDUCATION PROGRAM (GRADE 5 ARALING PANLIPUNAN)

- 1. This refers to the conduct of the Hybrid Division Contextualization of the Curriculum for Indigenous Peoples Education Program on December 5-7 and December 9, 2022 at a venue to be announced at a separate Memorandum.
- 2. The objectives of this training are:
 - 2.1To develop a holistic perspective on the overall learning and socio-cultural context of indigenous cultural communities (ICCs);
 - 2.2 To document, with elders/culture-bearers of the ICCs, stories of the places within the ancestral domain. These stories of ICCs will be developed as learning resource materials to be utilized in teaching Grade 5 Araling Panlipunan (AP). Stories will be written in nine (9) indigenous peoples (IPs) languages with Pilipino translations.

4. The participants from IPEd implementing schools are required to submit at least five (5) quality assured storybooks right after the training to the google link which will be provided; and those JHS catering IP learners must submit a guidance program for IP learners. Participants in this writeshop are expected to have laptops and strong wifi connectivity.



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- 5. Expenses to be incurred in this training shall be charged against 2022 IPEd Program Support Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedure.
- 6. All School Heads are reminded of DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2015, Instituting Measure to Increase Engaged Time on Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith. Classes in host schools must not be disrupted and there must be substitutes to those teachers attending the activity.
- 7. This Memorandum serves as travel authority of the participants.
- 8. Health and safety protocols based on IATF guidelines will be strictly implemented and followed.
- 9. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
