ENHANCED CAPABILITIES OF RFTAT AND DFTAT IN TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROVISION FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF SCHOOL STANDARDS TOWARD HIGHER PERFORMANCE

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Division Chiefs Division Education Program Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors All Others Concerned

- 1. Anent to the communication letter prepared by the Office of the Chief of the FTAD on capacity building in the provision of technical assistance, the Regional and Division Field Technical Assistance Team (RFTAT and DFTAT) work together to pursue the goals and strengthen the pillars of the Basic Education Development Plan 2030 (BEDP). The activity is anchored on RA 9155 or the Governance of Education Act of 2001 that addresses the current challenges faced by the basic education sector. Consequently, with the nationwide dissemination of DM 75, s.2022 "Moratorium on the Conduct of Division and Regional School-Based Management (SBM) Validation Activities", this has created an opportunity from the FTAD to provide technical assistance to SDOs to prepare them from the challenges of School-Based Management (SBM) Assessments.
- 2. In line with this, the RFTAT and DFTAT shall conduct a capacity-building on technical assistance to twenty SDOs which shall be divided into clusters from November 22-25, 2022. The Bulacan Cluster composed of SDO Bulacan, SDO Meycauayan City and SDO City of San Jose Del Monte shall have its one-day activity on November 24, 2022. This will be participated by one hundred seventy-five (175) participants from the three Schools Division Offices. Participants to this activity are public schools district supervisors, select elementary and secondary school heads to be identified by their respective SDOs.
- 3. Attached is Enclosure No. 1, List of Participants from this Office. This Memorandum shall serve as the Travel Authority of all participants.
- 4. Attached is Enclosure No. 2, Matrix of Activities as reference.
- 5. It is expected that all participants shall observe minimum health protocols to continuously prevent the spread of COVID-19 viruses.





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- 6. All expenses to be incurred in the aforesaid activity shall be charged against the General Appropriations Fund (SUB-ARO No. DepEd-ROIII-2022-11-2733) to cover meal expenses and materials for the various activities under the Field Technical Assistance Division-FTAD subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 7. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are earnestly desired.
