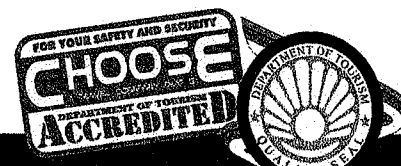
The story will end happily with an event discussing mental health issues. There is hope even when your sick mind tells you there isn't.

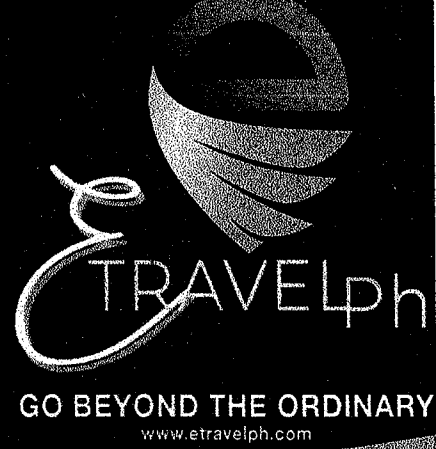
