



- Vaccination in schools as per concerned grade/section's available schedule
- Vaccination of enrollees at the LGU's health centers/vaccination sites, based on the list provided by the school point person
- Vaccination during weekends at the LGU's health center/vaccination sites
- Close planning and coordination between LGUs, PDOHOs focal persons, and Department of Education
