In line with the resumption of face-to-face classes, the resumption of the School Based Immunization (SBI) Program will begin starting October 2022. The details of the activity are as follows:

VACCINE	TARGET POPULATION	REMARKS
Measles Rubella	Grade 1 and 7 enrollees	Continue vaccination, however, existing stocks at LGUs will be used for implementation
Tetanus Diptheria	Grade 1 and 7 enrollees	No vaccination due to stockout of vaccine
Human Papillomavirus Vaccine	Grade 4 female enrollees (9-14 yrs old only)	Continue vaccination and will expand in January 2023 thru a contextualized SBI strategy to Aurora, Balanga City, Malolos City, Meycauayan City, City of San Jose Del Monte, and Tarlac City

With this, as a partner's role and function stated in the DOH Dept. Memorandum No. 2015-146 "Guidelines on the Implementation of School-Based Immunization," may we request your support through an issuance of a memorandum on the facilitation and information dissemination to school clinic staff/teachers/parents/students regarding resumption of SBI. We acknowledge the need to implement health services in school settings without interruption of classes. Thus, we encourage strategies to balance our agency's objectives. - Vaccination in schools as per concerned grade/section's available schedule
- Vaccination of enrollees at the LGU's health centers/vaccination sites, based on the list provided by the school point person
- Vaccination during weekends at the LGU's health center/vaccination sites
- Close planning and coordination between LGUs, PDOHOs focal persons, and Department of Education
