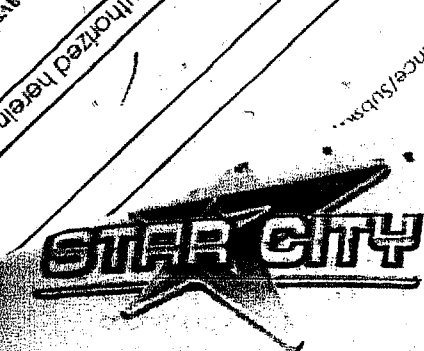



Without a doubt, dinosaurs are a popular topic for kids across the planet. Something about these extinct creatures from long ago seems to hold the attention of young or old, boy or girl. ## WHAT CAN STUDENTS LEARN FROM DINOSAURS?

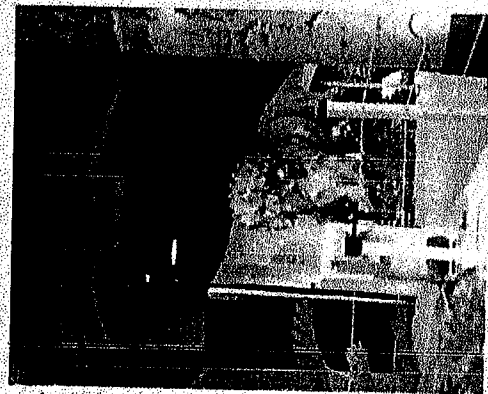

## SO HOW CAN YOU HELP AND ENCOURAGE THE DINOSAUR LOVERS IN YOUR HOUSE?

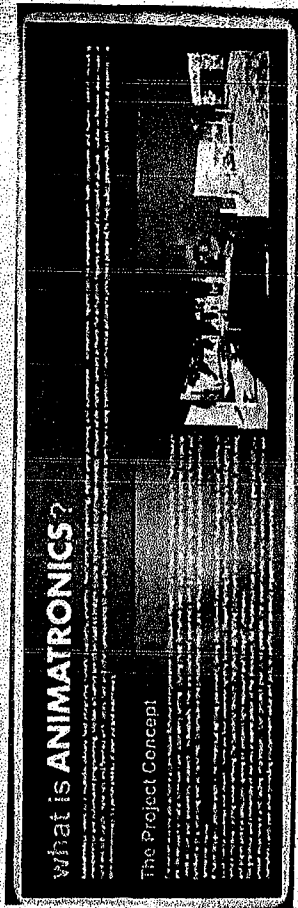
Star City now brings these magnificent creatures to life in a grand animatronics exhibition called "Dinosaur Alive!" Staged in an indoor breeding laboratory, the prehistoric creatures are showcased amid their natural setting in natal intensive care during their formative years.



The colossal grandeur and immensity of the lifelike movements, as rendered by Hualong Co. Ltd (the same group behind Jurassic Park, Universal) generates excitement, wonder, and overwhelming

On display are 8 different species -- the Velociraptor, a Pteranodon, the Tyrannosaurus Rex, Stegosaurus, Parasaurolophus, Ankylosaurus, Brachiosaurus, and the Triceratops -- with motor sensors activating varied motions from parts of the head, down to the tail, along with the corresponding sounds. As the animals are portrayed in their infancy stage, various types of medical apparatus including egg-hatching equipment supplement the narratives on hand.

Learning about dinosaurs in certain chapters of science textbooks provides opportunity for study across wide subject areas like history. Learning about the way they lived until the eventual extinction teaches your child about how science plays a role in the biodiversity of the earth both in the past and in the present.



Technology and Engineering also, plays a vital component in the presentation of these dinosaurs through animatronics which refers to the automated mechatronic robotics using applied hydraulics, pneumatics and clockwork. The use of sensors, mechanical movements, the dynamics of physics and motions are parts of subject matters in mathematics and science.

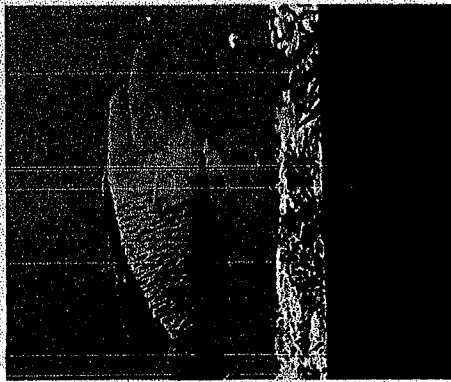

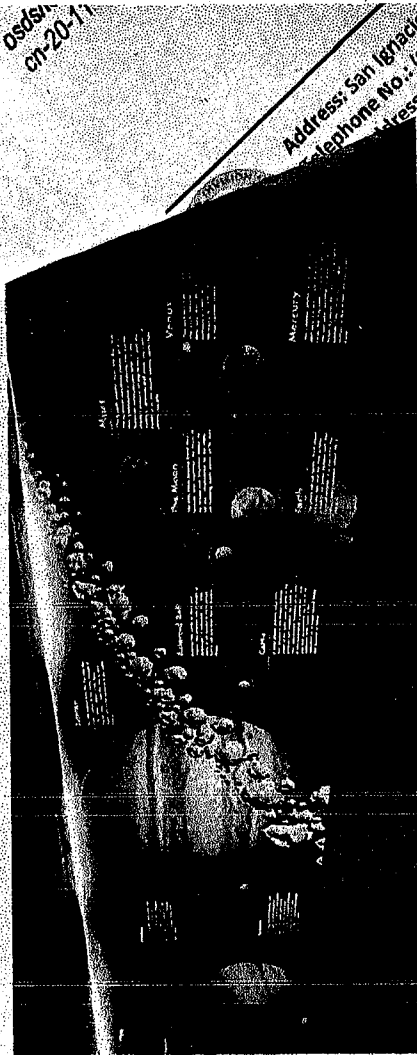
Virtual reality within four walls, doubled with a surround sound system, provides viewers with dynamic scenes in spherical cinematic mode. The seamless blending of spatial imagery provides a wondrous information gallery that envelops viewers in seemingly infinite surroundings.

In partnership with Australia-based PulseFX and Tekconsultgroup Singapore, Star City now boasts of a Digital Surround Theatre which provides visitors with a 360-degree immersive experience up in outer space and down amid marine life in Tubbataha Reef — all within 388 square meters that can hold up to 120 viewers at any given time.

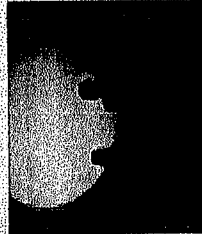
## SPACE VOYAGE

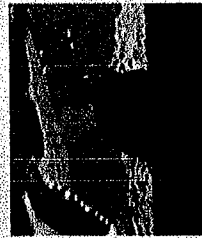

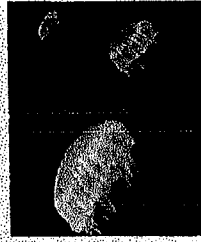
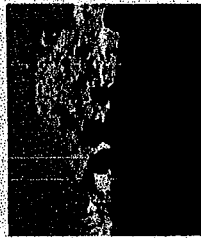


## INTO THE OCEAN

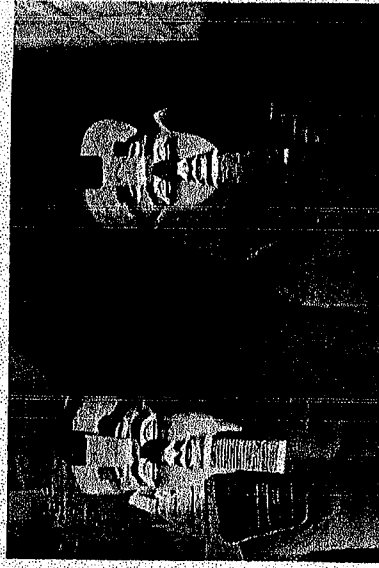

# TIME WARP ADVENTURE

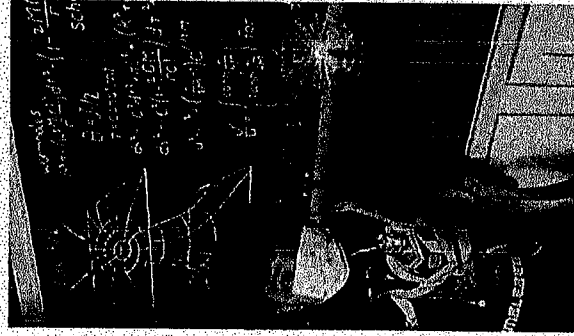

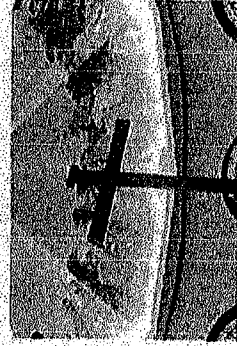

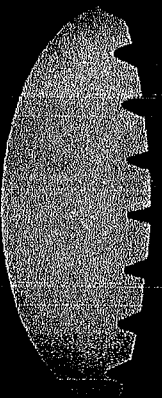


A series of hallways then opens up to an exhibit of generational memorabilia, and interactive portraits which actually sing.

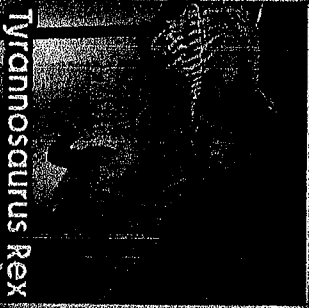


Although seemingly disparate with its hodgepodge exhibition displays, Time Warp shows visitors the unprecedented connectivity of the ancient and modern worlds.

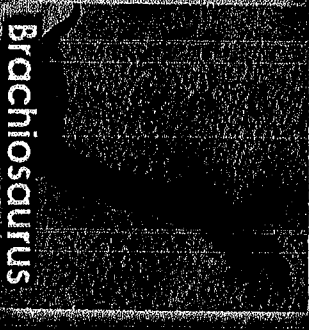
