Greetings from ACT Teachers Party-List!

ACT Teachers Party-List continues its advocacy for the education sector in the 19th Congress. Pursuant to this, we have filed several proposals for salary upgrading, as well as higher benefits and improved welfare of our teachers, education support personnel, and other education stakeholders.

We have filed House Bill 203 or "An Act Upgrading the Salary Levels of Public School Teachers to Salary Grade 15 and Teaching Personnel in Higher Education to Salary Grade 16, and Increasing the Salaries of Non-Teaching Personnel to P16,000," and House Bill 6560 or "An Act Establishing the National Minimum Monthly Salary in Government and Providing Funds Therefor" which provides for a P33,000 minimum salary for all government employees.

These House Bills are among the priorities of ACT Teachers Party-List, included in our legislative agenda for the 19th Congress, to help alleviate the sad plight of teachers and government employees by upgrading their salaries. At present, the salary of an entry-level teacher or education support personnel is still inadequate to meet the standard family cost of living.

In view of the above and in aid of legislation, this Representation would like to request your good office to facilitate the conduct of a face-to-face consultation on salary upgrading, through the issuance of a memorandum. A memorandum from your office will be of great help towards disseminating information about the activity and promote the attendance of the Faculty Club President or one authorized representative in every school in the Divisions of San Jose Del Monte, Bulacan, Mafelos City, and Meycauayan City.

The Consultation will be on February 17, 2023, Friday, 2:00-5:00 PM at P. Bernardo Elementary School, #172 P. Tuason, Kaunlaran, Quezon City. We will ensure the schedule with the schools and that there will be no disruption of classes as prior arrangements will be done.
