h. Must have a college degree and/or sufficient demonstrated ability and experience related/relevant to the course he/she is applying for	6. For Faceto-Face Course: Proficient in English (proven by a scan of the original certificate) with a minimum score of 450 for TOEFL or 5 for IELTS
i. Must have a good command of the English language (spoken and written)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This **SCHOLARSHIP CONTRACT AGREEMENT**, made and entered into this ____ day of _____, 2023, in _____, Philippines, by and between:

The **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DepEd)**, a National Government Agency mandated by law, with principal place of office at DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City, represented by its Undersecretary for Human Resource and Organizational Development, National Educators' Academy of the Philippines, and Teacher Education Council Secretariat, **DR. GLORIA JUMAMIL-MERCADO**, hereinafter referred to as "**DepEd**";

- WITNESSETH -

1. That in consideration of the participation of the SCHOLAR to the Senior Executive Class Batch 12 (SEC 12) to be administered by the Development Academy of the Philippines - Public Management Development Program (DAP-PMDF), the SCHOLAR shall observe the following terms and conditions:
 - a. To diligently complete ALL requirements for the program and maintain standards set for by the DAP-PMDF and the Department of Education (DepEd);
 - b. To conduct himself/herself in such manner as not to bring disgrace or dishonor to himself/herself, the DAP-PMDF and the DepEd;
 - c. To return to his/her official station and resume my function immediately after the training phase;
 - d. To submit to BHROD-HRDD a copy of the modular outputs, capstone paper and certified true copy of diploma in Development Management;
 - e. To serve a compulsory obligation of one (1) year in the DepEd after the awarding of the Diploma in Development Management to ensure return of investment (ROI); and
 - f. To pay the actual amount of the assistance provided for failure to meet the conditions of the grant through his/her own fault or neglect, resignation or voluntary separation.

2. That in view of the current pandemic due to the Coronavirus 2019 (Covid-19), the SCHOLAR shall:
 - a. Comply with the health protocols and public health standards imposed by the National Government, Local Government Units and his/her concerned office; and
 - b. Immediately inform DepEd and DAP-PMDP as to any critical illness/disease acquired within the duration of the Class; and secure health certification/ clearance prior to SCHOLAR's resumption for the program.
