

Dear Dr. Eclar,

Security Bank Foundation, Inc. (SBFI) will be launching this 2023 its inaugural 3-year training program for school principals on instructional leadership, contextual school problem solving, and stakeholder engagement in partnership with Ateneo de Manila University Center for Educational Development (ACED), The HEAD Foundation (THF) of Singapore, and the University of Nottingham (UoN) of the United Kingdom.

The training program will be conducted using in-person and online delivery modes where the in-person sessions will be held in the Ateneo De Manila University, Quezon City.

We are prioritizing the **principals of SBFI classrooms beneficiary schools in Luzon** as the initial pool of applicants to undergo a selection process to fill the **30 slots for batch 2023**. See Annex 1 for the list of SBFI classrooms beneficiary schools in Luzon.

In line with this, we would like to request the Department of Education (DepEd) Regional Office to issue a memo to endorse this training program to the DepEd Schools Division Superintendents having jurisdiction over SBFI beneficiary schools in Luzon.

We have sent a letter to the DepEd Central Office dated February 10, 2023 to formalize partnership with the DepEd for the training program and endorse this for support by the DepEd Regional and Division Offices. See Annex 2 for the copy of the letter.

The Program

The Program involves the participation of the following parties as Program Partners:

The Certificate Program is known as "Certificate for Educational Studies in Leadership" or CESL.

The CESL is a 4-month program combining in person and online trainings designed to develop school leaders using different strategies for leadership learning. These approaches include:

- lectures:
- self-paced learning;
- problem-based learning;
- extensive use of communities of practice through guided reflection sessions, planned encounters with critical friends and mentors from the faculty of UoN, industry leaders and graduates of the program.

2. The Program requires a 3-year training commitment of the principal and will involve the following:

- Year 1 (2023) theme of transformation focus on SELF
 - o 10 online sessions
 - 2 Face to Face training sessions of 3.5 days each session as part of the 4-month CESL Program
- Year 2 (2024) theme of transformation of SCHOOL
- Year 3 (2025) theme of transformation of COMMUNITY

3. The Year 1 (2023-2024) training calendar is as follows:

25-28 Oct 2023

Online CESL Sessions

4. Program Eligibility

The Program is open to Principals of public schools in LUZON where SBFI has a donated school building (SBFI beneficiary school). Specific eligibility requirements and application requirements are presented as Annex 4 and 5 of this letter. A total of 30 participants will be admitted to the Program.

5. Application Requirements

The application requirements include:

- An essay (1,000 words) to be accomplished by principal answering the following questions
 - How can I implement educational transformation in my context? (i.e. What is the key leadership issue that I intend to address?)
 - How significant is this proposed educational transformation?
 - How do I plan to implement this transformation?
- An accomplished Application Form (refer to Annex 3) including relevant requirements for submission

- ✓ Has thoroughly reviewed and will comply with all requirements indicated on the Program Details sheet (Annex 3)









Proponents and Program History

The HEAD Foundation is a Singapore-based charity organization whose vision involves the improvement of the quality of education in Asia by being a thought leadership center, especially in educational leadership.

University of Nottingham is one of the top 20 universities in the United Kingdom and is active in positioning itself as a top research university. Its research centers include the center for educational leadership and management.

Together, these two institutions introduced the "Certificate for Educational Studies in Leadership" or CESL program in 2018, launching it in Jakarta, Indonesia then continuing it in the Philippines in 2019 and 2021 in partnership with Ateneo Center for Educational Development.

In 2023, Security Bank Foundation, Inc. (SBFI) joined the partnership with the objective of bringing the CESL program as a component of its 3-year training program for school principals on instructional leadership, contextual problem solving, and stakeholder engagement, prioritizing principals of SBFI classrooms beneficiary schools as initial training program beneficiaries.

Certificate in Education Studies in Leadership (CESL) 4.0

Fresh from the successful completion of three international rounds of this programme, the principal partners have agreed to embark on a terminal round. The Certificate in Education Studies in Leadership (CESL) will be provided by UoN's CRELM (United Kingdom) with financial, logistical and intellectual support from THF (Singapore), the Ateneo Centre for Educational Development (ACED) and possibly from another private partner - the Security Bank Foundation Incorporated (SBFI).

CESL is a stand-alone learning module in which participants are not officially enrolled in a UoN course. CESL is designed as a 30-credit unit (at least 30 hours contact time). CESL is designed to provide qualified school leaders, teachers and educational officers with a repertoire of knowledge, skills and dispositions enabling them to implement effective, culturally-based and context-responsive leadership in the school system. The target cohort number for the fourth round of CESL (beginning 2023), to be implemented in a hybrid mode, is around 130 Filipino participants.¹

The Design Principles: Blended Learning, Experiential Learning and COPs

The design principles of CESL revolve around three core concepts: (1) the use of strategies for leadership learning that balances online synchronous and asynchronous sessions; (2) the application of experiential learning through guest lectures and visits built around

problem-based learning approaches and (3) the extensive use of Communities of Practice (COPs) through guided reflection sessions and planned encounters with Critical Friends/Mentors. Alumni of the past three runs will serve as mentors and facilitators, to guide and share their experiences with the next cohort.

Mode of Delivery: 4 months, three subjects

These design principles have been created to come up with a customised four month programme. Upon successful completion of the project, the participants will be provided with Certificates of Completion. There are three subjects to be covered in the two and a half month programme, namely: (1) Educational Leadership Landscapes; (2) Essentials of Educational Leadership and Change and a third individual-based action research component: (3) Enacting Transformational Action Plans (TAPs).

For 2023 onwards, the CESL programme will be conducted in its original hybrid mode with a total of two Face 2 Face (F2F) sessions of 3.5 days each, and at least two webinars. These sessions will be complemented by two individual tutorials for each of the participants. A final culminating meeting will serve as an conference/showcase event - an Education Roundtable - highlighting the TAPs of the participants.

CRELM will be responsible for designing, developing and implementing the programme, including the online lectures, webinars, guided reflections and tutorials.

UoN Accreditation and Costs

Upon completion of the programme, UoN CRELM through the School of Education, will provide Certificates of Completion to all the participants. From the perspective of UoN the participants are viewed as individuals undertaking professional development programs offered by the university.

Fees and Penalties

No fees will be collected from the participants.

Participants, however, will be required to enter into a contract with SBFI and THF. The contract will stipulate, among other things, that participants who fail to attend all the sessions will be required to refund the fees shouldered by Security Bank Foundation, The HEAD Foundation and University of Nottingham. The contents of the contract will be discussed in detail before the programme commences.

Equipment and Internet Access

The participants are also requested to secure the necessary equipment (i.e. laptops, speakers, headphones, etc) and stable internet connection necessary for the conduct of all programme components
