**DIVISION SELECTION OF EDDIS LEVEL ART PAINTING ENTRIES  
IN PREPARATION TO REGIONAL ART COMPETITION**

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 122 s. 2023, re: *Invitation to Join an Art Competition in Celebration of the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Diplomatic Relations Between Egypt and the Philippines*, this Office shall have a Division selection of EDDIS level entries (one entry (painting) per Category A: Grade 1-3, and Category B: Grade 4-6) on June 8, 2023, at School Division Office Conference Hall.
2. The two chosen entries will receive the endorsement of the DepEd SDO Bulacan and be submitted to the DepEd Regional Office III-Curriculum and Learning Management Division (DepEd RO III-CLMD).
2. This competition intends to showcase the talents of Filipino learners in the arts, discover from their perspective via their artworks, and reflect on the depth of friendship between the two countries.
3. The mechanics of the contest are as follows:
  - a. Entries should follow the theme, "*Egypt in the Eyes of the Filipino Children*".
  - b. All entries / paintings shall be on illustration board (15 x 20 inches) using either oil pastel or crayon.
  - c. The contest is open to all public elementary pupils.
  - d. There are two (2) contest categories:
    - Category A: Grades 1 -3
    - Category B: Grades 4 - 6
  - e. Each EDDIS should submit two (2) entries/outputs adjudged as **Champion** and the **First Runner Up** (Please break the tie as the case may be) for each category in the Division Office on or before June 8, 2023, for the final judging as the SDO Bulacan entries to the regional level.
  - f. With regards to the conduct of competition, the schedule of EDDIS level activities are as follows:

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**Contest Mechanics:**

1. Entries should follow the theme, "Egypt in the Eyes of the Filipino Children".
2. All entries/paintings shall be on illustration board (15 x 20 inches), using either oil pastel or crayon.
3. The contest is open to all public and private elementary students.
4. There are two (2) categories:  
Category A: Grades 1-3  
Category B: Grades 4-6  
\*\* Two (2) students may collaborate and work together on one (1) entry provided that they belong to the same school and grade level.
5. Each DepEd Regional Office should submit one (1) entry for each category to the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD) on or before July 7, 2023 for final judging.
6. Winning entries shall become the property of the Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt while non-winning entries shall be the property of the event organizer should it not be claimed in 90 days after awarding ceremonies.
7. The winners (per category) will receive a crystal trophy and the following cash prizes:

8. Prizes shall be provided and covered by the Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt.
9. The schedule of the Awarding Ceremony shall be on July 20, 2023 and the venue shall be announced through an Advisory.
