REITERATION OF PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES FOR THE SUMMER SEASON

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Division Chiefs
Education Program Supervisors
Public Schools District Supervisors
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
Elementary and Secondary School DRRM Coordinators
All Others concerned.

1. As summer heat continue based on the daily weather forecast of different agencies that provides public information, the daily average temperatures will incline on the month of May with the transition to El Nino in the month of June and July 2023. Extreme heat may cause, heat exhaustion, heat cramps, and heat stroke which may lead to unfavorable condition to learners and school personnel.

2. It is important that we take necessary precautions to ensure the safety and well-being of our learners, teachers, and employees. The following measures should be followed.

- a. Stay hydrated: during hot weather, it is important to stay hydrated by drinking plenty of water and avoiding sugary drinks or alcohol.
- b. Sun Protection: Wear a hat, sunglasses, and sunscreen with SPF to protect your skin from harmful UV rays of the sun.
- c. Be cautious with outdoor activities: avoid strenuous outdoor activities during the hottest parts of the day. Schedule outdoor activities during the early morning or late afternoon when the temperatures are cooler.
- d. School drills shall be conducted in the morning to avoid heat exhaustion among learners and teachers.
- e. Physical Education and Agriculture outdoor activities shall be planned properly to avoid related incidents.
- f. Everyone is encouraged wearing comfortable clothing, uniform is optional.
- g. Encourage learners to bring face towel to be used to freshen-up.





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- h. It is suggested to bring foldable fan, or fan (abaniko)
 - i. Update the rescue hotline numbers; all teachers shall save in their cellphone the rescue hotline numbers for immediate coordination and on time possible rescue responses.
