





### Mr. Gerardo Borromeo CEO of Phil. Transmarine Carriers

In 2021, Philippines had over 380,000 seafarers and was the world's top provider of seafarers or over a quarter of all global shipping merchant crew members. In 2022, the European Maritime Safety Organization (EMSA) flagged 20+ audit issues against Philippine training institutions which threatens the livelihood of over 50,000 Filipino seafarers.

In this session, we will learn about the various maritime organizations such as EMSA, IMMAJ, and Marina as well as the International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers (STCW) what went wrong and how can we save our seafarers from being deprived of employment






Ma. Christina G. Aquino is a highly experienced tourism professional who has held various positions in tourism-related organizations.


