The evaluation of original documents shall be based on DepEd Order 3, s. 2016 on the Hiring Guidelines for Senior High School (SHS) Teaching Positions Effective SY 2016 – 2017, DepEd Order No. 51, s. 2017 Amended Qualification Standards for Senior High School Teaching Positions in the Technical-Vocational Livelihood Track and Other Clarifications on the Hiring Guidelines, and DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2007 on the Revised Guidelines on the Appointment and Promotion of Other Teaching, Related-Teaching and Non-Teaching Personnel. No additional documents shall be accepted after July 28, 2023.

- Copy of PRC Rating/License
- Latest CSC Attested Appointment (or SDS signed appointment in lieu of attested appointment if still not released by CSC)

- Omnibus Certification of Authenticity and Veracity of Documents
