Pinas Forward e-Bayanihan Ideathon 2023 is the first ever nation-building ideathon aimed at propelling multiple tech-for-good civic projects at once. This 2-month **social development problem-solving conference** will gather and **empower 60 selected young visionaries** from various parts of the country for them to **learn innovative strategies** through the **Design Thinking framework** and apply these in their initiatives.

Pinas Forward and partner guest experts will equip delegates as they develop and possibly implement their community projects, applying the insights and technical skills they learn from the sessions.

What's In It For You?

Pinas Forward e-Bayanihan Ideathon can empower you to roll-out your socio-civic project through the following:

- ✓ Learning the framework for project planning and execution
- ✓ Meeting and learning from experts in community organizing, socio-civic project building, design thinking, and technology
- ✓ Connecting with fellow youth visionaries for future collaborations

Guidelines

- Open to all Filipinos aged 16-25 years old (Senior High School to College Level)
- Must join in groups of 2-3 members; must have at least 2 non-minors
- Must have a **tech-for-good civic project concept** in mind addressing any of the following:
 - Unemployment / Underemployment
 - Access to Livelihood
 - Access to Education
 - Online Safety & Combating Disinformation
 - Food Security
- Project must not have been funded yet by any local/international institution
- If initially implemented, project must not have reached city/municipality level

How to Apply

STEP 1: APPLICATION

DEADLINE JULY 31

Interested participants must submit the online application form which includes the project concept.

STEP 2: SCREENING

All submitted entries will be screened and scored according to Vision & Intent, ICT Integration, and Success & Sustainability Potential.

STEP 3: ANNOUNCEMENT OF DELEGATES

AUGUST 9

Teams who have passed the screening process will be informed of their successful application and admission to the ideathon via email and through social media announcements. Congratulations!

The Ideathon Journey

IDEATHON KICK-OFF: AUGUST 19

The conference begins! In a virtual program, teams will come together to learn about the current context of the country in terms of the 5 social challenges, one of which their initiatives aim to address.

VIRTUAL WORKSHOP SESSIONS

Delegates will be taught innovative strategies on how to operationalize their initiatives through the Design Thinking framework. Attendees of Workshop 4 have the option to participate in the session in-person.

- September 2 - Technology for Social Good
- September 9 - Technology for Social Good + Insighting with Mentors
- September 16 (hybrid) - Project Presentations + Insighting with Mentors
- September 23 - Guide to Project Operationalization

MONITORING AND DELIBERATIONS

Regular monitoring by and communication with the organizers continue throughout the implementation phase. Soon after, the panel of judges will evaluate the community projects, particularly on their impact.

GRADUATION AND AWARDING: OCTOBER 7

Teams reconvene for an on-site graduation ceremony as they celebrate the end of the program and the progress of their projects. Special awards will be given.
