**DELIVERY OF SELF-LEARNING MODULES FOR KINDERGARTEN TO
GRADE 12, SY 2023-2024**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendents
Division Chiefs
Public Schools District Supervisors
Elementary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. Steadfast in its preparation for School Year 2023-2024, the Department of Education (DepEd) will provide Self-Learning Modules (SLMs) with alternative learning delivery modalities to be offered for various types of learners across the Philippines.
2. Relative to this, DepEd issued Joint Memorandum DM-OUCT-2023-014 which stated in the item 2 that the SLMs should remain the primary learning resources for various distance learning delivery modalities and supplementary learning resources for in-person classes from kindergarten to Senior High School. The SLMs and the other alternative learning delivery modalities are in place to address the needs, situations, and resources of every learner and will cover all the bases in ensuring that basic education will be accessible amid Education in Emergencies (EIEs).
3. The delivery of SLMs for Kindergarten to Grade 6 for the First Quarter of SY 2023-2024 shall commence on August 25, 2023. Though it has been announced that work in public offices was suspended on the said date due to the opening of FIBA World Cup at Philippine Arena, the members of District Inspectorate Team (elementary) are advised to receive the delivery on the said date. They shall be given compensatory time-off.
4. Guided by this policy, all School Heads must monitor the utilization, useful life, storage, and maintenance of procured and delivered SLMS in their

respective schools. It is advised that delivered SLMS, including the locally produced, must be distributed to the learners for utilization.

5. Immediate and wide dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
