**ADMINISTRATION OF NATIONAL LEARNING CAMP ASSESSMENT  
(POST TEST) FOR INCOMING GRADE 8 AND 9 LEARNERS  
SCHOOL YEAR 2023-2024**

1. Consistent with Regional Memorandum 441, s. 2023 and the issuance of Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) DM-CT-2023-230 titled Administration of National Learning Camp Assessment (Post Test) among incoming Grades 8 And 9 Learners, School Year 2023-2024, this Office shall administer the Post Test of the National Learning Camp for the incoming Grade 8 and 9 on the following schedules:

- a. Enhancement Test - September 4 to 8, 2023
- b. Consolidation Test - September 11 to 13, 2023
- c. Intervention Test - September 14 to 15, 2023
- d. Pre -Test takers who did not participate in NLC – September 19 -22, 2023

2. Computer Based Assessment covers **English, Mathematics and Science** measuring the varying levels of competencies in multiple choice format aiming to identify the effectiveness of learning camp on the learning proficiencies of the participating learners after the program.

3. All participating schools shall ensure the readiness of the computer laboratories and computer units with the assistance of the Division and School ICT/ITO and other assigned personnel in-charge of the security and safety during the administration of the examination. Likewise, the Division ICT and school ICT shall check and update the email address of all examinees to ensure correct log-in credentials in the Learning Management Credentials (LMS) Moodle Platform.





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4. This Memorandum shall serve as the travel authority of all personnel involved in monitoring activities of the conduct of these assessment in connection to NLC.
5. Participants are expected to observed health and safety protocols in compliance to health standards to prevent the spread of any infectious diseases.
