- 1. Anent to Regional Memorandum 456, s. 2023 on the 2023 Teacher's Got Talent, this Office announces the search for SDO Bulacan Teacher's Got Talent on September 14, 2023.
- 2. The search may cover any type of act or performance such as singing, dancing, acting and other relevant performance showcasing the God given talents to teachers. It is open to all teachers either individual or group performances. If it is a group performance, the maximum number of participants is ten (10) members.
- 3. For equal opportunity, all EDDISs are encouraged to send one (1) entry either from elementary or secondary group to join the division level. Entries must be submitted to this Office on or before September 13, 2023.
- 4. Performance shall be pre-recorded in a landscape format. Participants can use any recording devices. The maximum time for the performance presentation is seven (7) minutes.
- 5. The criteria for judging are as follows:

| Category                      | Percentage |

| Talent and Skill              | 50%        |
| Originality and Creativity    | 25%        |
| Projection and Overall Impact | 25%        |
| Total                         | 100%       |

6. Evaluation of the said competition shall be through judging the recorded entries. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.

#### 2023 Search for Teacher's Got Talent Guidelines and Mechanics

- The Search is open to all private and public teachers of basic education in DepEd Central Luzon.
- 2. The Search may cover any type of act or performance such as singing, dancing, acting and other relevant performance showcasing the God given talents of teachers. If joining as a group, a maximum of ten (10) members shall be allowed. Previous champions are not allowed to join the contest to give chance to others.
- 3. For equal opportunity, all Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are encouraged to conduct Division Wide Teacher's Got Talent Search. Each SDO shall submit one (1) entry. The deadline of submission is on or before September 18, 2023 using attached TGT Official Nomination template in Annex B through this link: http://tinyurl.com/2023-TGT-Entries.
- 4. The performance shall be pre-recorded in a landscape format. Participants can use any recording devices such as mobile phone, digital camera etc. The maximum time for the performance's presentation is seven point zero (7.0) minutes. Excess second/s or minute/s from the prescribed time, two (2) points shall be deducted from the total score of the participant.
- 5. Only the Division Partnership Focal Person (DPFP) is authorized to upload the TGT Official Nomination Form and the recorded video performance of the official representative of the SDO in the above stated google drive link on or before September 18, 2023 with the file name division\_TGT\_fullnameofthecontestant. Late submission of entry shall not be accepted.
- 6. The criteria for judging are as follows.
