DIVISION TRAINING WORKSHOP ON THE STRENGTHENING/ FUNCTIONALITY OF THE CHILD PROTECTION COMMITTEE (CPC) AND LEARNER PROTECTION IN SCHOOLS

- 1. In line with DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 titled "DepEd Child Protection Policy," all public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide shall establish a functional Child Protection Committee (CPC) in schools, and Regional Memorandum No. 339, s. 2023, the Schools Division Office of Bulacan shall conduct a Training Workshop on the Strengthening/Functionality of the Child Protection Committee (CPC) and Learner Protection in schools on September 25-26, 2023, 8:00 AM 5:00 PM, at the 3rd Floor Conference Hall, SDO Bulacan. This is in recognition of the vital role of school CPCs in ensuring that all learners are protected, safe and free from all forms of abuse. Furthermore, the school CPCs shall plan, implement, and promote advocacy programs, projects, and activities in relation to learner protection.
- 2. The objectives of the said activity are as follows:
 - identify existing DepEd policies and issuances on learner rights and protection;
 - 2.2. determine specific functions of the Child Protection Committee (CPC) in schools;
 - 2.3. understand the duties and responsibilities of the school in the handling of learner rights and protection incidents;
 - 2.4. streamline case management protocols for efficient handling of learner rights and protection concerns;
 - harmonize all procedures and interventions implemented in schools in relation to learner protection;
 - 2.6. revisit local child protection policy of the schools; and

- ensure that all incidents of child abuse, violence, exploitation, discrimination, bullying and other similar acts are properly addressed.
- 3. The training shall be participated by 33 Elementary School Heads (1 Representative per District) to be identified by the Public Schools District Supervisor and 24 Secondary School Heads (4 Representative per EDDIS) to be identified by the EDDIS Chairs. This Office encourages the participants to cascade the training to their respective District and Eddis.
- 4. Expenses to be incurred in the conduct of the said activity shall be charged against the Program Support Funds (PSF) while the transportation expenses of the participants shall be charged against school local funds, both subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. This Memorandum shall serve as the travel authority of all participants.
- Attached is the Regional Memorandum No. 339, s. 2023, Conduct of Training Workshop on the Strengthening of the Child Protection Committee (CPC) and Learner Protection in Schools for reference.
- It is expected that all participants observe health protocols during the conduct of the said activity to prevent any spread of infectious diseases.

- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 40 s, 2012 titled "DepEd Child Protection Policy", all public and private secondary and elementary schools nationwide shall establish a functional school Child Protection Committee (CPC), thus, Department of Education (DepEd) Regional Office III is fully committed in strengthening and promoting learner's rights and safety through establishment of a fully functional Child Protection Committee in Schools.
- 2. Furthermore, the Child Protection Committee (CPC) in schools has a vital role in ensuring that all the learners are protected and safe from abuse, violence, exploitation, bullying and all other forms of abuse. In addition, CPC shall plan, implement and promote advocacy programs, projects and activities relative to the learner protection.
- 3. In order to strengthen the CPC in schools, the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) through the Division Learner Rights and Protection Focal Persons (DLRPFPs) are advised to conduct **Training Workshop on Strengthening of the Child Protection Committee and Learner Protection in Schools** not later than the fourth week of September 2023. In addition, the DLRPFPs shall inform this Office on the specific date/s in the conduct of such activity for monitoring purposes.
- 4. The target participants to this training workshop are all public and private school heads of both elementary and secondary schools.
- Enclosure is the allocation of each Schools Division Office (SDO) to be downloaded as Program Support Fund (PSF) in the conduct of capacity building for the Chairpersons of the school Child Protection Committee.
- Should the PSF is not enough to support the capacity building, the SDOs through the DLRPFPs may engage in collaboration and partnership with their

respective Local Council for the Protection of Children (LCPC) such as Provincial Council for the Protection of Children/ City/Municipal Council for the Protection of Children/Barangay Council for the Protection of Children for the support resources.

- 7. Likewise, the DLRPFPs are requested to submit the Activity Completion Report (ARC) and Utilization and Liquidation Report using the attached template through this google drive link:

 October 16, 2023.
- Travel and other expenses incurred by the participants in attending the
 activity shall be charged against the local funds subject to usual auditing and
 accounting rules and procedures.
