- In support of the implementation of the Special Needs Education Program, this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division announces the conduct of Division Training ON THE Utilization of Filipino Sign Language (FSL) and Braille Reading for SNEd Receiving Teachers on November 28-29. 2023 at Pulilan Central School, Pulilan District.
- 2. The training workshop aims to:
  - 2.1 heighten pedagogical knowledge, skills, and attitude of SNEd Receiving Teachers concerning the management of LWDs, especially in teaching Filipino Sign Language and Braille Reading:
  - 2.2 ensure the provision of quality education to learners with hearing and visual impairment;
  - 2.3 design, adapt, and support the delivery of the SNEd program through the implementation of teaching strategies responsive to learners' needs;
  - 2.4 foster empathy and sensitivity towards the unique challenges faced by learners with special needs
- 3. The participants in this activity are the following SNEd and Receiving
  - 30 Secondary Teachers ( 3 SNEd Teachers and 2 Receiving Teachers per EDDIS)
  - 99 Elementary Teachers (2 Receiving Teachers per District and 1 SNEd Teacher per
  - 8 Resource Speakers, and 5 TWG (Total 142 participants)
- 4. The travel expenses and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
