**DIVISION TRAINING-WORKSHOP ON THE DIFFERENT
APPROACHES AND STRATEGIES IN TEACHING 21ST CENTURY
SKILLS IN ARLING PANLIPUNAN**

1. The Department of Education – MATATAG Agenda significantly promotes to “Make the curriculum relevant to produce competent, job-ready, active and responsible citizens.” The result of the Regional diagnostic test and revealed that the MPL in questions that assess critical analysis is below 60%. Out of the yielded results, questions involving problem-solving, and innovation ranked next. It can also be noted that written communication skills need to be given attention in having learners explain and explore on the topics given. These skills are among the 21st-century skills needed by our learners. In line with the progressive implementation of K to 12 enhanced curriculum and MATATAG agenda on curriculum improvements, a Division Training Workshop in the Different Approaches and Strategies in Teaching 21st Century Skills in Araling Panlipunan will be conducted on January 24-26, 2024, at Villa Emmanuela Resort, Plaridel, Bulacan.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. Review the four skills areas of the 21st century skills: critical thinking and problem solving, communication, collaboration, and creativity and innovation;
 - b. Reflect on the participants own practice and share their experiences and challenges with their co teachers;
 - c. Apply various approaches and strategies that foster 21st century skills in the teaching-learning process in Araling Panlipunan; and
 - d. Design learning plans and performance-based assessments that measure learners 21st century skills in Araling Panlipunan and SHS - HUMSS



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3. Participants to this activity are the following:
 - a. Elementary – 33 District Araling Panlipunan Coordinators
6 District AP Advisers (1 AP Adviser per EDDIS)
 - b. Secondary – 104 JHS AP Coordinators
25 JHS AP Master Teachers
