1. Ensuring effective and relevant learning experiences for all learners highlights the significance of an inclusive and holistic approach to learning assessment. The current and developing abilities of learners should be assessed to determine the extent of intended learning outcomes in relation to the key stage learning standards.
2. To fully adhere to the mandates of assessment in the different learning outcomes, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), conducted a series of activities that involved the development, validation, and finalization of the assessment tools in all learning areas from Key Stage 1 to 3 and Core Subjects in Key Stage 4 that will be used in the Regional Achievement Test



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sometime in May 2024, with technical guidance from the concerned regional and division learning area supervisors.

3. In line with this, the Department of Education Regional Office 3, through the CLMD, shall conduct a pilot testing of the said assessment tools with the select Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and schools with the supervision of the concerned Regional and Division Learning Area Educational Program Supervisors.
4. The pilot testing of assessment tools aims to:
 - a. assess the clarity, usability, and reliability of the developed, validated, and finalized assessment tools in all learning areas from key stage 1 to 3 and core subjects in key stage 4 to ensure alignment with the educational standards and curriculum requirements;
 - b. identify the items that require revision and need to be discarded; and
 - c. solicit feedback from educators and learning area supervisors to make informed revisions and improvements to the assessment tools before nationwide implementation.
5. All the select Division Education Program Supervisors (EPSs) in each learning area shall prepare the updated version of the Assessment Tools and other materials needed to conduct the pilot testing and shall coordinate with the select schools to produce testing materials.
6. The printing and/or reproduction of the assessment tools shall be charged to the School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and other local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules.
7. All schools involved in the pilot testing shall ensure the veracity and security of the assessment tools and these shall be administered properly. The school heads shall strictly supervise the conduct of the pilot testing.
8. Each curriculum leader per grade level of the select schools in Key Stages 1 to 4, after the administration of the pilot testing, shall immediately perform item analysis, item banking, and narrative report using the template found in this link: <http://tinyurl.com/Item-Analysis-RAT>. They shall submit the consolidated report to the school head of the select school indicating the list of specific items that need **to be retained, revised, and discarded** where the report templates are also found in the link previously cited.
9. All consolidated reports from the schools shall be submitted to the schools division for proper consolidation by the select division EPS after the pilot testing. Likewise, division consolidated summary reports on the conduct of the pilot test of




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the assessment tools in All Learning Areas from Key Stage 1 to 3 and Core Subjects in Key Stage 4 shall be submitted to the regional office **five days** after the administration of the test. All reports should be properly endorsed to the regional office in PDF file along with the MS Word file. The Regional EPS per learning area shall provide the link for the uploading of those files.
