**PROVINCIAL-DIVISION UPSKILLING OF JOURNALISTIC COMPETENCIES
OF THE SDO BULACAN TEACHER-COACHES AND LEARNER-QUALIFIERS
TO THE 2024 REGIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE**

1. The Campus Journalism (CJ) Act of 1991 is perhaps one of the strongest laws that protects the rights of the student-journalists and preserves the integrity of student publications in the elementary and secondary levels in the Department of Education. Through campus journalism programs and activities, learners together with their teacher-coaches are given opportunities to strengthen their ethical values, encouraging and establishing critical thinking, and expressing their ideas and opinions in the current issues and events. For this reason, this Office shall conduct Provincial-Division Upskilling of Journalistic Competencies of the SDO Bulacan Qualifiers to the 2024 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC) to be held on April 1-4, 2024 at Dr. Felipe De Jesus National High School, Agnaya, Plaridel.
 2. This co-curricular activity aims to:
 - 2.1 upskill the writing competencies of the campus journalists and teacher-coaches in the different campus journalism contests;
 - 2.2 recognize the significant role of journalism in advocating social consciousness and environmental awareness;
 - 2.3 conduct training sessions to address the gaps in line with the journalistic skills; and
 - 2.4 produce winning campus journalism outputs aligned with the prerequisites of contests.
 3. Participants to this intensive training-workshops are the Top 3 Winners in 9 Individual Writing Categories and Top 1 Winners in Radio-Broadcasting and Scriptwriting Contest, including the identified RSPC contestants in Collaborative Desktop and Online Publishing and TV Broadcasting, English and Filipino, Elementary and Secondary Levels.
 4. Enclosure No.1 contains the matrix of activities and the Division Campus Journalism TWG Core Group/Speakers/Facilitators.
 5. Public and private elementary and secondary school heads concerned are strongly encouraged to provide moral and financial support as well as any suitable consideration to their teacher-coaches, journalism coordinators, and School Paper Advisers (SPAs). They are to be given service credits and pertinent incentives for their dedication and commitment to the campus journalism activities following the appropriate DepEd guidelines and mandates.
 6. Teacher-coaches and School Paper Advisers (SPA) are required to submit training development plans and schedule of sessions with their campus journalists to ensure that essential contact hours shall be devoted to other curricular activities and learning episodes. Henceforth, all school heads are reminded of the DepEd Order No. 9, S. 2005, "Instituting

Measure to Increase Engaged Time on Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.” Classes must not be disrupted and there must be substitutes to those SPAs in the conduct of the activity.

7. All learner-journalists must have parent’s/guardian’s letter of consent to be submitted to their teacher-coaches and School Paper Advisers (SPA) allowing them to join and participate in the said intensive trainings. Similarly, they should be given pertinent academic considerations during the training-workshop sessions to cope with their learning episodes.
8. Strictly, **no monetary and non-monetary fees** shall be taken from the parents and learners. Instead, all food and refreshments and snack expenses to be incurred in the conduct aforesaid training-workshop shall be charged to Provincial School Board Funds while transportation and incidental expenses of the participants shall be taken from the Student Development Canteen Funds/MOOE/LSB/local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. This Memorandum serves as travel authority of the persons involved during the conduct of the Campus Journalism activities.
10. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
